Reason: For heroism in connection with military operations against a hostile force: Sergeant Adderly distinguished binary operations

force: Sergeant Adderly distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous actions on 11 May 1966, near Bu Gia Map, Republic of Vietnam. When his platoon sergeant was killed during an assault against a well-entrenched enemy, Sergeant Adderly, a squad leader, immediately assumed the responsibilities of platoon sergeant. Exposing himself to enemy fire, he maneuvered his men, encouraging them and pointing out targets. While under extremely heavy hostile fire, he was instrumental in the destruction of three machine gun positions and also directed the clearing of landing zones for evacuation of the wounded. Sergeant Adderly's devotion to duty and personal courage were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service, and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States
